

ORDINANCE NO. 74-75

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of the Southeast Quarter of the South-  
east Quarter of Section Three (3), Township  
Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West, in Monroe  
County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows,  
to-wit: Beginning at a point that is 297.00 feet  
West of the Southeast corner of the Quarter  
Quarter Section; thence running West 120.00 feet;  
thence North 200.00 feet; thence West 105.00  
feet; thence North 460.00 feet; thence East 225.00  
feet; thence South 660.00 feet and to the place  
of beginning, containing in all 2.93 acres, more  
or less.

The above description describes a tract of land  
lying North of Moores Pike and East of Winfield  
Road.


SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries  
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby  
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate  
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor  
and publication in accordance with the law.


