

ORDINANCE NO. 74-77

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northwest Quarter of Section
Nine (9), Township Eight (8) North, Range One
(1) West, described as follows: Beginning at
a point that is 1,329.16 feet South and 1,634.25
feet West of the Northeast corner of the North-
west Quarter of aforesaid Section; thence run-
ning North 87 degrees 30 minutes East along the
centerline of Miller Drive a distance of 533.5
feet; thence South 16 degrees East for a dis-
tance of 616.5 feet; thence South 87 degrees
30 minutes West for a distance of 533.5 feet;
thence North 16 degrees West along the center-
line of State Highway #37 for a distance of
616.5 feet, and to the place of beginning, con-
taining 6.97 acres, more or less.

The above description describes a tract of land
lying at the Southeast corner of South Highway
37 and Miller Drive and includes Bloomington
Southgate Shopping Center.


SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington,
Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by
the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.


