

ORDINANCE NO. 74-78

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northwest Quarter of Section
Nine (9), Township Eight (8) North, Range
One (1) West, Monroe County, Indiana, de-
scribed as follows: Beginning at a point
1329.16 feet South and 1634.25 feet West
of the Northeast corner of said Northwest
Quarter and at the intersection of State
Road #37 (Walnut Street) and Miller Drive;
thence North 16 degrees West for 100 feet
on State Road #37; thence North 14 degrees
30 minutes West on State Road 37 centerline
for 214.00 feet; thence North 77 degrees
East for 225 feet; thence South 12 degrees
30 minutes East for 25.00 feet; thence
North 77 degrees East for 400 feet; thence
South 12 degrees East for 382 feet and to
the Centerline of Miller Drive; thence
South 87 degrees 30 minutes West on the
centerline of Miller Drive for 619.00 feet
and to the point of beginning.

The above description describes a tract of
land lying at the Northeast corner of South
Highway 37 and Miller Drive and includes
among other properties, the Ardmore Apart-
ments.


SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries

hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.


