

ORDINANCE NO. 74-79

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the North one-half of Seminary  
Lot Number 134, Monroe County, Indiana,  
bounded and described as follows, to-wit:  
Commencing at the Northeast corner of said  
Seminary Lot Number 134, thence South for  
854.37 feet; thence West for 370.28 feet;  
thence North for 202.00 feet; thence West  
26.22 feet; thence North for 652.37 feet;  
thence East for 396.57 feet and to the point  
of beginning.

The above description describes a tract of  
land lying at the Southwest corner of Maxwell  
Lane and South High Street.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries  
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby  
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate  
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington,  
Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and  
effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by  
the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.


