

ORDINANCE NO. 74-80

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of the southeast quarter of the southeast  
quarter of Section Three (3), Township Eight (8)  
North, Range One (1) West, in Monroe County,  
Indiana, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning  
at a point on the South line of said quarter  
quarter that is 246.3 feet East of the Southwest  
corner of the said quarter quarter, running North  
363.00 feet; thence East 380.00 feet; thence  
South 363.00 feet; thence West 380.00 feet to the  
place of beginning, containing 3.17 acres, more or  
less.

The above description describes a tract of land  
lying at the Northeast corner of Moores Pike and  
Valley Forge Road.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries  
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby  
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate  
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor  
and publication in accordance with the law.
