

ORDINANCE NO. 74-93

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range
1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly
described as:
Lots numbered 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and
18, inclusive, Miller Courts Addition to the
City of Bloomington as platted and recorded in
Plat Book 3 , page 83 , Monroe County Recorder's
Office.

The above described real estate describes lands ly-
ing North of 19th Street and between Walnut and
Washington Streets, and includes the site of Park-
view Apartments.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the
Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
