

ORDINANCE NO. 74-97

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southwest quarter of Section 28,
Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County,
Indiana, described as follows: Beginning at
a point 1013.76 feet South and 1665.0 feet
West of the Northeast corner of said quarter,
said point being in center of State Highway
#37; thence running North 13 degrees 30 minutes
West 398.85 feet on and along center line of
said highway; thence running East 470.80 feet;
thence South 393.84 feet; thence West 424.0
feet, and to the point of beginning, contain-
ing 4.05 acres.

The above description describes land owned by
American Fletcher Mortgage Company lying East
of State Highway #37 North of 20th Street and
South of State Highway #46 By-Pass.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington,
Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the
Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.


