

ORDINANCE 74-114

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2.04.630
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, ENTITLED "COUNCILMANIC DISTRICTS"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 2.04.630 of the Municipal Code
of the City of Bloomington is now amended to read as follows.

The City is divided into six councilmanic districts
which shall be known as first district, second district,
third district, fourth district, fifth district and
sixth district. Such councilmanic districts shall be
made up of the following described areas of the City:

(1) First District. The First Councilmanic
District shall consist of the following:

a. All that part of the City lying within the area
bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection
of Indiana 37 By-pass West and Indiana State
Highway 45 running thence East along State
Highway 45 to Walker Street, thence South along
Walker Street to First Street, thence East
along First Street to Morton Street, thence
North along Morton Street to Second Street,
thence East along Second Street to the alley
midway between College Avenue and Walnut Street,
thence North along said alley to Seventeenth
Street, thence East along Seventeenth Street
to Walnut Street, thence North along Walnut
Street to Old Highway 37, thence North along
Old Highway 37 to State Highway 37, thence
North along State Highway 37 to the North boundary
of Section 21 of Bloomington Township, thence
West along the North boundaries of Section 20
and 21 of Bloomington Township to the Indiana
37 By-pass West, thence South along Indiana 37
By-pass West to Indiana State Highway 45 to the
place of beginning.

b. All that part of the City lying in Van
Buren Township.

c. All that part of the City lying in Richland
Township.

(2) Second District. The Second Councilmanic
District shall consist of the following:

a. All that part of the City lying within the
area bounded as follows: Beginning at the
intersection of Ninth Street and the alley
midway between College Avenue and Walnut Street
and running thence North along said alley to
Seventeenth Street, thence East along Seventeenth
Street to Walnut Street, thence North along
Walnut Street to Old Highway 37, thence North
along Old Highway 37 to State Highway 37, thence
North along State Highway 37 to the City boundary,
thence East along the City boundary to Dunn
Street, thence South along Dunn Street to
Indiana By-pass East (State Roads 45 and 46),
thence East along said By-pass to the City
boundary, thence North and East and South to

include the First Assembly of God Church on said By-pass to Fee Lane, Thence South on Fee Lane to include the Unitarian Church, thence South along Fee Lane to Seventeenth Street, thence East along Seventeenth Street to the City boundary, thence North, East, and South to include St. Paul's Catholic Church, thence East along Seventeenth Street to North Jordan, thence South along North Jordan Avenue to Tenth Street, thence West along Tenth Street to Woodlawn Avenue, thence South along Woodlawn Avenue to Eighth Street, thence East along Eighth Street to Dunn Street, thence North along Dunn Street to Ninth Street, thence (East) west along Ninth Street to the place of beginning.

(3) Third District. The Third Councilmanic District shall consist of the following:

- a. All that part of the City lying North of East Third Street and East of Indiana By-pass East (State Roads 45 and 46).
- b. All that part of the City lying North of a line running East along Tenth Street to the point where the Illinois Central Railroad Line crosses East Tenth Street and Southeast along the Illinois Central Railroad tracks to Indiana By-pass East (State Roads 45 and 46), and East of North Jordan Avenue.
- c. All that part of the City lying South of East Third Street and East of College Mall Road.
- d. All that part of the City South of Moores Pike and East of Sare Road.
- e. That property located at 1606 North Fee Lane.

(4) Fourth District. The Fourth Councilmanic District shall consist of the following:

- a. All that part of the City lying South of East Third Street, West of College Mall Road, North of Moores Pike and East of High Street.
- b. All that part of the City lying South of Moores Pike, West of Sare Road, North of Rogers Road, and East of High Street.
- c. All of that part of the City lying within the area bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of East Third Street and Indiana By-pass East (State Roads 45 and 46) running thence North along said By-pass to the Illinois Central Railroad tracks, thence Northwest along said railroad tracks to East Tenth Street, thence West along East Tenth Street to Jordan Avenue, thence South along Jordan Avenue to Seventh Street, thence East along Seventh Street to Union Street, thence South along Union Street to East Third Street, thence East along Third Street to Indiana By-pass East (State Roads 45 and 46) to the place of beginning.
- d. All that part of the City lying within the area bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of High Street and Hunter Avenue running thence West along Hunter Avenue to Jordan Avenue, thence South along Jordan Avenue

to Davis Street, thence East along Davis Street to the East property line of Sarkes Tarzian, Inc., thence South along the Sarkes Tarzian, Inc. property line to Hillside Drive, thence East along Hillside Drive to High Street, thence North along High Street to Hunter Avenue to the place of beginning.

(5) Fifth District. The Fifth Councilmanic District shall consist of the following:

a. All that part of the City lying within the area bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of First Street and Walnut Street thence South along Walnut Street to the South boundary line of Section 16 in Perry Township, thence West along the South boundary lines of Sections 16, 17, and 18 of Perry Township to the Indiana 37 By-pass West, thence North along Indiana 37 By-pass West to Indiana State Highway 45, thence East along Indiana State Highway 45 to Walker Street, thence South along Walker Street to First Street, thence East along First Street to Walnut Street to the place of beginning.

b. All that part of the City lying within the area bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of First Street and Walnut Street thence South along Walnut Street to Rhorer Road, thence East along Rhorer Road to the East boundary of Section 15 in Perry Township, thence North along the East boundary of Section 15 in Perry Township to Rogers Road, thence West along Rogers Road to High Street, thence North along High Street to Hillside Drive, thence West along Hillside Drive to the East property line of Sarkes Tarzian, Inc., thence North along Sarkes Tarzian, Inc.'s East property line to Davis Street, thence East along Davis Street to Jordan Avenue, thence North along Jordan Avenue to Hunter Avenue, thence West along Hunter Avenue to Fess Street, thence South along Fess Street to First Street, thence West along First Street to Walnut Avenue to the place of beginning.

(6) Sixth District. The Sixth Councilmanic District shall consist of the following:


a. All that part of the City lying within the area bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of Morton Street and First Street thence North along Morton Street to Second Street, thence East along Second Street to the Alley midway between College Avenue and Walnut Street, thence North along said alley to Ninth Street, thence East along Ninth Street to Dunn Street, thence South along Dunn Street, to Eighth Street, thence East along Eighth Street to Woodlawn Avenue, thence North along Woodlawn Avenue to Tenth Street, thence East along Tenth Street to Jordan Avenue, thence South along Jordan Avenue to Seventh Street, thence East along Seventh Street to Union Street, thence South along Union Street to Third Street, thence East along Third Street to High Street, thence South along High Street to Hunter Avenue, thence West along Hunter Avenue to Fess Street, thence South along Fess Street to First Street, thence West along First Street to Morton Street to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
