AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE GENERAL FUND, EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET THE EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST IN THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;
