

APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE No. 74-5

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE SPECIAL FUNDS, EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA TO MEET THE EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST IN THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergencies, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the Revenue Sharing Trust Fund of said City, not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year of 1974 than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:

From: REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND

To: DRUG COMMISSION

1 SERVICES PERSONAL

#11 Salaries and Wages.....\$5,835.00

5 CURRENT CHARGES

#51 Insurance.....93.80

6 CURRENT OBLIGATIONS

#62 Social Security.....341.35

Total Funds: \$6,270.15

SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
