## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 74-7

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE SPECIAL FUNDS, EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET THE EXTRA-ORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST IN THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS.
