

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 74-11

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM A SPECIAL FUND, EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET THE EXTRA-ORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, certain extra emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget:

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extra emergencies, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND of said City funds not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extra emergencies found to exist for the expenditure of money for the current year of 1974, than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sum:
