

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 74-17

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget:

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergencies, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the Special Fund of said City, funds not otherwise appropriated to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year of 1974 than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums, to-wit:

PARK DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION FUND

To Construction Costs \$11,538.69

This amount being interest that has accumulated from investments of the above named Park District Construction Fund which must be appropriated before expenditures can be made.

SECTION II. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


