

ORDINANCE NO. 73-2

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A USER CHARGE FOR
EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Bloomington, Indiana, shall
make available emergency transportation for ~~the residents of~~^{persons in}
Monroe County who suffer emergency illness or injury requiring
transportation to a hospital.

SECTION 2. That said emergency transportation shall be
furnished through the facilities of the City of Bloomington,
Indiana.

SECTION 3. That the Chief of the Fire Department and
City Controller shall set up such procedures and appoint such
persons as are necessary for the orderly collection, recording
and deposition of said funds collected.

SECTION 4. That the fee for said service shall be Ten
(\$10.00) Dollars and shall be deposited in the General Fund of the
City of Bloomington.

SECTION 5.

That the Chief of the Fire Department shall be
empowered to make an administrative determination that, in any
given instance, a collection of the fee provided for in Section
4 would work a financial hardship, in which instance such fee shall
not be collected.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect after its passage, promulgation and approval by the Mayor.
