

ORDINANCE NO. 73-8

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land, be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Part of the southwest quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Nine (9) North, Range Two (2) West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded as follows, to-wit: Beginning 24 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Southwest quarter; running thence East to the Northeast corner of said southwest quarter; thence South 110 rods; thence West to a point 24 feet East of the West line of said southwest quarter; thence North 110 rods to the place of beginning; EXCEPTING THEREFROM THE following described lands, to-wit:

A parcel of land 20 feet in width, being 10 feet in either side of the following described centerline: a first segment beginning at a point 1350.19 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 36; thence running on a 16 degree curve to the left with a radius of 358.17 feet a distance of 119.39 feet; thence south a distance of 717.4 feet to a point of a curve; thence on a 16 degree curve to the left having a radius of 358.17 feet a distance of 562.71 feet; thence East a distance of 842.75 feet excepting from the said First Segment of Railroad right of way easement a strip of land 4 feet in width off of the North side of said First Segment, said strip running West for a distance of 626 feet from the East terminus of said First Segment; and a Second Segment beginning at a point 1370 feet West and 262.60 feet South of the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 36, running thence South 7 degrees 9 minutes East a distance of 84.10 feet to a point of curve; thence on a 16 degree curve to the left with a radius of 358.17 feet a distance of 518.02 feet; thence East a distance of 852.88 feet, excepting from the said Second Segment of Railroad right-of-way easement a strip of land 4 feet in width off the South side of the said second segment, said strip running West for a distance of 646 feet from the East terminus of the said Second segment; and a Third Segment beginning at a point 925 feet West and 655 feet South of the Northeast

corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 36, running thence North 82 degrees 51 minutes East a distance of 104 feet; thence East a distance 320 feet to a point of curve; thence on a 16 degree curve to the left with a radius of 358.17 feet a distance of 517.81 feet; thence North 7 degrees 09 minutes East a distance of 62.19 feet; thence North 230 feet; and a Fourth Segment beginning at a point 142 feet West and 252 feet south of the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 36; running thence South a distance of 416 feet, all in Monroe County, Indiana.

Said above described real estate is the property of General Electric Company, located at 301 Curry Pike.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
