

ORDINANCE NO. 73-25

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

The following described real estate in Monroe County,
State of Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southwest quarter of Section 28, Township
9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, des-
cribed as follows: Beginning at a point that is 1013.76
feet South and 813.0 feet West of the Northeast corner
of said Southwest Quarter; thence running North 730.50
feet; thence running west 528.0 feet; thence running
South 336.66 feet; thence running East 100 feet;
thence running South 393.84 feet; thence running East
428.0 feet and to the place of beginning, containing
7.95 acres more or less.

Said above described real estate is located immediately
North of the Howard Johnson Motor Lodge on State
Highway #37.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.
