

ORDINANCE NO. 73- 32

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Section 36, Township 9 North, Range 2
West, Richland Township, Monroe County, Indiana,
described as follows: Beginning at a point, said
point being the northeast corner of Highland
Village 2nd Addition as recorded in Plat Book
4, page 84 in the Monroe County Recorder's Office,
thence south along the west right-of-way of Curry
Pike to a point, that point being the intersection
of the West right-of-way of Curry Pike and the
North right-of-way of Whitehall Pike (Indiana
State Highway #48), thence West along the North
right-of-way of said Whitehall Pike to a point,
said point being the southwest corner of Highland
Village Addition as recorded in Plat Book 4, page
65, in the Monroe County Recorder's Office, thence
North along the west boundaries of Highland Village
Addition and Highland Village 3rd Addition as
recorded in Plat Book 4, page 89 in the Monroe County
Recorder's Office to a point, said point being the
Northwest corner of said Highland Village 3rd Addition,
thence East along the north boundaries of Highland
Village 3rd Addition and Highland Village 2nd Ad-
dition and to the point of beginning.

The above described real estate comprises Highland
Village Additions 1 through 3, and the Highland
Village Church of Christ.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of
the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.
