

ORDINANCE NO. 73- 33

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of Section 13, Township 8  
North, Range 2 West, Van Buren Township, Monroe  
County, Indiana.

The above described real estate comprises Van  
Buren Park Additions 1 through 8, Chateau Van  
Buren Apartments, and a tract of land owned by  
Trustees of Woodhaven Christian Church.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of  
the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are hereby de-  
clared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate  
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington,  
Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor  
and publication in accordance with the law.
