

An Ordinance to Amend Sections 14.36.160 and 14.36.170 of the Bloomington Municipal Code

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Section 14.36.160 Fences adjacent to swimming pools--required be amended to read as follows:

14.36.160 Fences adjacent to swimming pools, ponds, quarries or other water-filled excavations -- required.

Every person in possession of land upon which is situated a swimming pool, pond, quarry or other water-filled excavation exceeding the depth of thirty-six (36) inches at its deepest point who fails to fence the area adjacent to said swimming pool, pond, quarry or excavation with a chain link, wire or board fence at least five (5) feet high and with no opening, except gates or doors, of more than four (4) inches in width so that the pool, pond, quarry or excavation is made inaccessible to children, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. That Section 14.36.170 Fences adjacent to swimming pools--Penalty for violation of Section 14.36.160 be amended to read as follows:

14.36.170 Fences adjacent to swimming pools, ponds, quarries, or other water-filled excavations -- Penalty for violation of of Section 14.36.160. Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 14.36.160 is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to such penalties as are prescribed in Section 1.01.130 of the Bloomington Municipal Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
