## ORDINANCE NO. 73-37

## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the same, is hereby annexed to and declared a part of the C ity of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Lots number one (1) and two (2) in Northcrest Addition, being a part of the southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana; excepting therefrom eighty-five (85) feet of even width off of the entire west end of lots number one (1) and two (2) in Northcrest Addition, being a part of the southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana.

Excepting, also, therefrom a part of lots number one (1) and two (2) in Northcrest Addition being a part of the southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning on the south line of lot number one (1) Northcrest Addition at a point 85 feet east of the southwest corner of said lot, thence running east on the south line of said lot for a distance of 75 feet and  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  inches to a point in line with the center line of a 4 inch partition wall; thence running north 184 feet to the north line of lot number two (2) in said Northcrest Addition, thence running west on and along the north line of said lot number two (2) for a distance of 75 feet and  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  inches to a point 85 feet east of of the northwest corner of said lot number two two (2), thence running suth 184 feet to the place of beginning.

Said above described real estate being the location of The Peoples State Bank Branch situated at West 17th Street and State Highway #37.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
