

ORDINANCE NO. 73-43

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 15.64 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 15.64.370, ENTITLED, "RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES-30 MINUTE ZONE", SECTION 15.64.330 INTRA-CITY BUS STOPS", SECTION 15.64.050 CERTAIN TRUCKS-MORE THAN TWO HOUR PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 15.64.370 of the Bloomington Municipal Code be amended by adding thereto the following location:

"The east side of Dunn Street between Fourth Street and Sixth Street between the hours of Seven o'clock A. M., and Five o'clock P. M., except Sundays and Holidays".

SECTION 2. That Section 15.64.330 of the Bloomington Municipal Code be amended by adding thereto the following locations:

"The South side of East Seventh Street from a point one hundred-twenty feet east of the Grant Street curb line and running thence east for a distance of ninety feet", also,

"The east side of Walnut Street from a point twenty-five feet north of the Sixth Street curb line and running thence north for a distance of forty-five feet".

SECTION 3. That Section 15.64.050 of the Bloomington Municipal Code be amended by adding thereto the following words:

"This Section shall not apply to Pick-up type campers, provided however, that no such vehicle shall park within fifty feet of an intersection, or alley."

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
