

ORDINANCE NO. 73-50

An Ordinance to Repeal Certain Sections of  
Title 14, "Peace, Safety, and Morals",  
of the Bloomington Municipal Code

WHEREAS certain sections of Title 14 of the City Code of  
Bloomington make criminal the same acts as certain state  
statutes, specifically:

AND, WHEREAS Indiana Code 35-1-21-1, Burns Indiana Statutes  
§9-2402, prohibits a city from making punishable by any ordinance  
any act made punishable by state statute,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY <sup>ordained</sup> RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1.: That Section 14.04.010, "Disorderly conduct--  
generally", of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 2.: That Section 14.04.020, "Assualt," of the City Code  
of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 3.: That Section 14.16.010, "House of ill fame", of  
the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 4.: That Section 14.16.020, "Prostitutes--wandering about  
the city," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 5.: That Section 14.16.030, "Prostitutes--harboring or  
keeping", of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 6.: That Section 14.16.040, "Public indecency", of the  
City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 7.: That Section 14.20.010, "Concealed weapons", of the  
City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 8.: That Section 14.24.060, "Allowing minors to congregate in billiard room," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 9.: That Section 14.36.040, "Begging," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 10.: That Section 14.36.060, "Iceboxes and refrigerators-- Removal of locks required in certain cases," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 11.: That Section 14.36.080, "Injury to property generally--Necessary destruction in case of fire excepted," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 12.: That Section 14.36.100, "Obscene prints and paintings," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 13.: That Section 14.36.110, "Police Officers-- Interfering with or resisting," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 14.: That Section 14.36.120, "Police Officers-- impersonating," of the City Code of Bloomington be repealed.

Section 15.: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
