ORDINANCE NO. 73-74

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 17.18.160 "COMPLAINT--HEARING--DECISION," OF THE CITY CODE OF BLOOMINGTON

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA

SECTION 1. That Section 17.18.160 "Complaint--Hearing--Decision" of the City Code of Bloomington be amended to substitute the word "more" for the word "less" and to read as follows:

17.18.160 Complaint--Hearing--Decision. Not more than ten (10) days after such hearing the Board shall make its finding, determination, and recommendation in writing to the Housing Code Enforcement Officer. Not less than a majority of the members of such Board present at a regular or special meeting shall concur in such finding, determination and recommendation. A copy of such finding, determination and recommendation shall be furnished to the person having possession of the premises together with the owner of the premises if the owner is not in possession.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
