An Ordinance Amending Section 2.79.040, Economic Development Commission Membership, of the Bloomington City Code.

WHEREAS, economic development of the City of Bloomington and vicinity is vital to the health and welfare of the community, and affects all, diverse elements of the community, and

WHEREAS, a five-member Economic Development Commission will allow greater diversity of membership than a three-member Commission will,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, that:

Section 1. 2.79.040 of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

"2.79.040 Membership. The Commission shall consist of five (5) members. Three (3) members shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the approval of the Common Council, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor. Two (2) members shall be appointed by the Common Council and shall serve at the pleasure of the Common Council. Each and every person appointed Commissioner shall be a resident of Monroe County. Commissioners shall serve from the date of appointment for an indefinite term until resignation, termination or expiration of the life of the Commission."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
