APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 73-11

AN ORDINANCE ESPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE LOCAL ROAD AND STREET FUND OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, FUNDS NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED TO MEET THE EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST IN THE SAID FUND:

WHEREAS, It has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the Annual Budget: NOW, THEREFORE,

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, that for the expenses of said municipal Corporation the following additional sumsof money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the Fund herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:
