

ORDINANCE NO. 72-6
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 15 ENTITLED,
"VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" BY AMENDING SECTION
15.64.410 ENTITLED, "NO PARKING ZONES" AND
SECTION 15.76.010 ENTITLED, "STOP INTERSECTIONS".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 15.64.410 entitled, "No Parking
Zones" be amended by adding thereto the following:

- a. The south side of East Second Street from Jordan Avenue to High Street.
- b. The south side of Fourteenth Street from Walnut Street to Dunn Street.
- c. The south side of Fifteenth Street from Walnut Street to Dunn Street.

SECTION 2. That Section 15.76.010 entitled, "Stop Intersections"
be amended by adding thereto the following:

- a. Right turn after stop on red light. North bound Indiana Avenue traffic turning East on E. 10th Street. South bound Indiana Avenue traffic turning west on E. 10th Street.
- b. Right turn after stop on red light. South bound Jordan Avenue traffic turning West on E. 3rd Street. West bound E. Third Street traffic turning North on Jordan Avenue.
- c. Right turn after stop on red light. West bound E. 3rd Street traffic turning North on Indiana Avenue.
- d. Right turn after stop on red light. South bound Washington Street traffic turning West on E. 3rd Street. East bound traffic on E. 3rd. Street turning South on Washington Street.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication
in accordance with the law.
