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ORDINANCE NO. 72-9

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BLOOMINGTON-MONROE DRUG CONTROL COMMISSION AND THE BLOOMINGTON-MONROE DRUG CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 71-19 be amended to read as follows: Section 2. Each of the following groups, organizations and institutions shall have the right to appoint to such Committee as its representative an individual whom it feels is qualified to serve upon such Committee. The groups, organizations and institutions which shall each appoint a member to the Bloomington-Monroe Drug Control Advisory Committee are:

> Monroe County Medical Association Indiana University Student Health Service Staff Monroe County United Ministries Monroe County Pharmaceutical Association Monroe County Dental Association Monroe County Bar Association Monroe County Mental Health Association Middle Way House Monroe County Community School Corporation Richland-Bean Blossom Community School Corporation Office of Dean of Students of Indiana University Student Government of Indiana University Indiana State Police City of Bloomington Police Department Monroe County Sheriff's Department Indiana University Department of Safety Board of Safety of City of Bloomington Prosecutor of Tenth Judicial Circuit Monroe County Federation of Labor League of Women Voters Chamber of Commerce of the City of Bloomington, Indiana Town of Ellettsville The High Schools in Monroe Coutny Monroe County Mental Health Clinic

In addition to the appointments made by the above groups, organizations and institutions, the City Judge of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, shall be a member of such Committee. The Bloomington-Monroe Drug Control Commission shall be free to include representatives from other groups, organizations and institutions within the community as it deems necessary for the purpose of greater community participation. Provided, however, that the Council may upon its own motion prohibit the inclusion of any group, organization or institution on the Commission.
