ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 72-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF BLOOMINGTON BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 1.01.130 ENTITLED "VIOLATIONS - PENALTY."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The City Code of Bloomington is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

1.01.130 Violations - Penalty. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any provision or to fail to comply with any of the requirements of this code. Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of this code, unless provision is otherwise herein made, shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment for a period of not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each such person shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision of this code is committed, continued, or permitted by such person and shall be punished accordingly. In addition to the penalties hereinabove provided, any condition caused or permitted to exist in violation of any of the provisions of this code shall be deemed a public nuisance and may be, by this city, summarily abated as such, and each day that such condition continues shall be regarded as a new and separate offense.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
