ORDINANCE NO. 72-25

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is adjacent to the real estate described herein

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northeast quarter of Section 13, Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana described as follows: Beginning at a point 550.00 feet North and 30.00 feet East of the Southwest corner of the said Northeast quarter, thence South 89 degrees 42 minutes 23 seconds East for 610.00 feet, thence North for 135.00 feet, thence North 89 degrees 42 minutes 23 seconds West for 20.00 feet, thence North for 165.00 feet, thence North 33 degrees 41 minutes 30 seconds East for 35.65 feet, thence North for 340.29 feet, thence North 89 degrees 42 minutes 23 seconds West for 330.00 feet, thence South for 340.00 feet, thence North 89 degrees 42 minutes 23 seconds West for 280.00 feet, thence South for 330.00 feet and to the point of beginning. Containing in all 7.11 acres more or less.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.
