

## ORDINANCE NO. 72-66

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the  
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Block "A" in Highland Village Fourth  
Addition, and being a part of the Northeast  
quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section One  
(1), Township Eight (8), North, Range Two (2)  
West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and  
described as follows: Beginning at a point on  
the South right-of-way line of State Road Number  
48, which point is five hundred ninety-four and  
seventy-two hundredths (594.72) feet West and  
Forty (40) feet South of the Northeast corner  
of the said quarter quarter, and which point is  
also the Northwest corner of the tract of land  
conveyed to Jerome A. Rueff and Joseph A. Pollard  
in Deed Record 182, at page 557, of the records  
of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana, thence  
running South three hundred and fifty-one hundredths  
(300.51) feet and to the South line of a twenty  
(20) foot easement running East and West; thence  
running South 89 degrees 25 minutes West over and  
along the said south line of the said twenty (20)  
foot easement for a distance of one hundred  
fifty (150) feet to a point; thence leaving the  
South line of the said twenty (20) foot easement  
and running North for three hundred two (302)  
feet on a line which is also the West line of the  
tract of land conveyed to the Grantors herein in  
Deed Record 170, at page 465, of the records of  
the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana, to a point  
in the South right-of-way line of State Road  
Number 48; thence East over and along the said  
South right-of-way line for a distance of One  
Hundred Fifty (150) feet to the place of beginning,  
containing in all one and three hundredths (1.03)  
acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of  
the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared  
to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove  
described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
