AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 17.12.160 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, ENTITLED "NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE ADOPTED"

WHEREAS, the Electrical Code of the State of Indiana has now been adopted as a standard for the installation, alteration and use of electrical equipment, fixtures and wiring and that such standards are applicable to installation, alteration and use of electrical equipment, fixtures and wiring in the City of Bloomington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 17.12.160 of the Municipal Code, entitled "National Electrical Code Adopted" be, and it is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
