ORDINANCE NO. 71-20

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 18.04.010
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, ENTITLED "ADOPTION"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 18.04.010 of the Municipal
Code of the City of Bloomington is now amended to read as
follows:

There is adopted by the city for the purpose of
prescribing regulations governing conditions
hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion,
that certain code known as the Fire Prevention Code,
recommended by the National Board of Fire Underwriters,
being particularly the 1970 Edition thereof and the
whole thereof, of which code not less than three copies
have been and now are filed in the office of the city
clerk and the same is adopted and incorporated as fully
as if set out at length herein, and from the date on
which this chapter takes effect, the provisions thereof
shall be controlling within the limits of the city.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force
and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication
in accordance with the law.


