ORDINANCE NO. 71-50

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON
ZONING MAP, DATED JULY 18, 1950

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950,
and

WHEREAS, said zoning ordinance and map are now incorporated in the
"Bloomington Municipal Code" as Title 20 of said Code, and

WHEREAS, The City Plan Commission has recommended that said
Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 174
OF THE 1947 ACTS, OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF
INDIANA:


SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated
July 18, 1950, be amended to rezone the following described land in the
City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, from its present B-3 GENERAL
BUSINESS ZONE classification to an M-1 GENERAL INDUSTRIAL ZONE, to-wit:

Lots numbered 53, 54, and 55 in Waterman's Addition to the
City of Bloomington, Indiana.


Said lots are located at the corner of Seventh and Adams
Streets.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.




