WHEREAS the Common Council in the State of Indiana
(Governing Body)
by Ordinance did, on the 17th (day) November (month) 1925 (year)
provide for the creation of City Plan Commission and

that the State of Indiana acting by and through the Department of Commerce provide such planning assistance as may be available under Section 701 of the Housing act of 1954 as amended.

3. That the Application for Urban Planning Assistance
by the City Plan Commission to the State of Indiana
(Plan Commission)
acting by and through the Department of Commerce, said application having been submitted to this body and having been duly reviewed and considered, is hereby approved.
