BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, that the Common Council hereby supports the recommended proposal of an approximately \$600,000.00 bond issue for implementing Phase I of the Comprehensive Plan for Parks and Recreation purposes, and urges its full support by the citizens of the City of Bloomington and the new administration taking office in 1972.
