APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 71-4

An Ordinance specially appropriating from the Special Funds not otherwise appropriated of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist in the various departments:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Special Funds of said City, not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditures of more money for the current year of 1971, than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:

- 1. Parking Meter - Controller \$1,800.00
- #26 - Contractural Services

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
