COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 70-15

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND  
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION  
FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is  
adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have  
submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory  
of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and  
the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 9  
North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana; beginning  
at a point that is 313.5 feet East and 707.54 feet North  
of the Southwest corner of said Section 35; thence West 48.96  
feet and to the East Right-of-Way line of State Highway #46;  
thence North 24 degrees 07 minutes West on and along said  
East Right-of-Way line 670 feet and to the North line of the  
Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section  
35; thence East on and along said Quarter Quarter line 768.2  
feet; thence South to the North Right-of-Way line of Third  
Street (State Highway #46) and the now existing corporation  
line; thence West on said corporation line 476 feet; thence  
North 667.54 feet more or less and to the point of beginning.  
Containing in all 17.5 acres more or less.

The Day Funeral Home and St. Mark's Methodist Church are  
located on the above described land.


SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the  
City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be  
extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described  
as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from  
and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication  
in accordance with the law.
