ORDINANCE NO. 70-21

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION
FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is
adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have
submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory
of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and
the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the West half of the West half of Section One, Township
8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana described as
follows: Commencing at an existing 3/4" iron pipe taken as the
Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section One,
and also as the Southwest corner of Highland Village 12th Addition;
thence South 88° - 14' East 1294.20 feet along the South line of
Highland Village to an existing fence corner post; thence South 01° - 16'
West 1485.77 feet along an existing fence line and fence line
extended to the centerline of Gifford Road, being the point of
beginning of the tract herein described; thence North 90° West
485 feet along said centerline; thence North 00° East 110 feet;
thence North 90° West 80 feet; thence North 00° East 100 feet;
thence North 90° West 120.33 feet; thence North 01° - 16' East
120.00 feet; thence North 60° East 220 feet; thence North 00°
East 65.00 feet; thence North 90° West 141.55 feet; thence North
27° West 295.26 feet; thence North 13° - 56' - 10" East 105.00
feet; thence South 76° - 03' - 50" East 80.00 feet; thence South
40° East 256.00 feet; thence North 71° East 125.00 feet; thence
South 43° - 11' - 35" East 324.27 feet; thence South 01° - 16'
West 140.00 feet; thence North 90° East 170.26 feet; thence South
01° - 16' West 318.99 feet to the point of beginning, containing
8.14 acres.

Also, a part of the West half of the West half of Section One,
Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described
as follows: Commencing at an existing 3/4" iron pipe taken as the
Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section One, and
also as the Southwest corner of Highland Village 12th Addition;
thence South 88° - 14' East 1294.20 feet along the South line of
Highland Village to an existing fence corner post; thence South 01°
- 16' West 1166.78 feet along an existing fence line and fence line
extended to a point 318.99 feet North of the centerline of Gifford
Road, being the point of beginning of the tract herein described;
thence North 90° West 170.26 feet; thence North 01° - 16' East
140.00 feet; thence North 43° - 11' - 35" West 324.27 feet; thence
North 36° - 05' - 32" West 511.32 feet; thence North 85" - 24' - 05"
East 711.34 feet; thence South 01° - 16" West 846.78 feet to the point
of beginning, containing 7.79 acres.

Also, a part of the West half of the West half of Section One,
Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described
as follows: Commencing at an existing 3/4" iron pipe taken as the
Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section One, and
also as the Southwest corner of Highland Village 12th Addition; thence
South 88° - 14' East 514.20 feet along the South line of Highland
Village to the point of beginning of the tract herein described;
thence continuing on said line South 88° - 14' East 780.00 feet to
an existing fence corner post; thence South 01° - 16' West 320.00
feet along an existing fence line; thence South 85° - 24' - 05"
West 711.34 feet; thence North 09° - West 406.00 feet to the point
of beginning, containing 6.17 acres.
