ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 70-35

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION
FOR VOJUNTARY ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is
adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have
submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory
of which the petitioners are the owners

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and
the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of Section 36, Township 9 North, Range 2 West,
Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows,
to-wit: Beginning at a point on the now existing Corporation
Line, said point being the point of intersection of the West
Right-of-Way line of Curry Pike and North Right-of-Way line
of State Highway number 48; thence North on and along said
West Right-of-Way line of Curry Pike to a point 263 feet
North of the South line of the Northeast Quarter of the
Northwest Quarter of said Section 36, Township and Range
aforesaid; thence West to a point 186 feet West of the North-
South half Section line of said Section 36; thence South 263
feet; thence West 1464 feet; thence North 679.8 feet; thence
East 1452 feet; thence South 62 degrees 40 minutes 36 seconds
East and to the East Right-of-Way line of Curry Pike; thence
South on and along said East Right-of-Way line of Curry Pike
to the now existing Corporation Line the same being the North
Right-of-Way line of State Highway number 48; thence West on
said existing Corporation Line to the point of beginning and
containing 27.4 acres more or less.

Also, a part of Section 36, Township 9 North, Range 2 West, in
Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-
wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter
of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 36, Township and Range
aforesaid; thence West on and along the North line of said Quarter
Quarter for a distance of 926.78 feet; thence South for a distance
of 932.3 feet and to the North Right-of-Way line of a Monon Rail-
road Switch Spur; thence Easterly on and along said Switch Spur
North Right-of-Way line for a distance of 1047.66 feet and to the
East line of the aforesaid Quarter Quarter; thence leaving said
Switch Spur Right-of-Way and running North over and along said East
line of said Quarter Quarter for a distance of 473.18 feet to the
point of beginning and containing 11.69 acres more or less.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the
City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be
extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described
as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on
January 1, 1972, after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.
