## ORDINANCE NO. 70-38

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR MILEAGE, VACATIONS, AND SICK DAYS FOR CITY EMPLOYEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That in all instances where employees of the City shall use their own vehicle in City affairs and work, other than travelling from their home to their place of work and from their place of work to their home, such employee shall be entitled to an allowance of \$.10 per mile for each mile actually traveled.

SECTION 2. Any City employee who shall have been employed by the City continuously for a period of not less than nine months shall be entitled to a vacation period of ten working days with pay. Such vacation period shall be arranged with, and subject to the approval of the head of the department by which the employee is employed. All vacation periods shall be taken, and no employee shall be entitled to work during the period for which the vacation is scheduled and collect double pay therefor.

All department heads shall be entitled to a vacation period of twenty working days with pay. The vacation periods of department heads shall be arranged by and subject to the approval of the appropriate City board.

SECTION 3. All City employees shall be entitled to be absent from work for a period of up to six days each year because of illness, and shall be paid for time lost because of illness up to six days each year. In the event any employee shall be absent from work because of illness fewer than six days in any one calendar year, then the time not taken shall be cumulative and shall be added to the time allowed for illness in each subsequent year, until the employee shall have accumulated sixty-six days, after which no further days shall be added to the time allowed for absence because of illness.

SECTION 4. Modifications and additions to the above sections may be adopted by the several city boards, namely the Board of Public Works, the Board of Public Safety, and the Board of Parks and Recreation concerning employees under their jurisdiction and with the approval of the Mayor
