AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND  
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION  
FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the said Northwest Quarter, said point being in the centerline of South High Street; thence North 89 degrees 07 minutes 00 seconds West for a distance of 650 feet; thence North for a distance of 555.16 feet; thence North 55 degrees 20 minutes 07 seconds East for a distance of 103.39 feet; thence North 37 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds West for a distance of 101.17 feet; thence North 24 degrees 57 minutes 00 seconds West for a distance of 422.63 feet; thence South 89 degrees 07 minutes 40 seconds East for a distance of 808.43 feet and to the centerline of South High Street; thence South, over and along the said line, for a distance of 1075.45 feet, and to the place of beginning, Containing 16.42 acres, more or less.

The above described territory is now recorded as Greenbrier Hills First Addition.


SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
