


A RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND APPROVING THE ACTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, IN ENTERING INTO A LEASE WITH THE TRUSTEES OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CARILLON TOWER.


WHEREAS, heretofore on the 15th day of October, 1970, the Board of Public Works of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, acting for and in behalf of said City of Bloomington, entered into a lease with the Trustees of Indiana University for the construction of a Carillon Tower on property known as Rogers Hill Reservoir; and

WHEREAS, said lease contains the covenants and agreements of the respective parties hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, hereby ratifies and approves the action of the Board of Public Works of the City of Bloomington in entering into a lease with the Trustees of Indiana University for the construction of a Carillon Tower.
