ORDINANCE NO. 69-10

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 66-18 AND
ABOLISHING THE ANIMAL CONTROL COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 66-18, 1966 of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, in its entirety is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That the Animal Control Commission created by Ordinance No. 66-18, 1966 is hereby abolished.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
