ORDINANCE NO. 69-11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ANIMAL CONTROL BOARD  
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-  
INGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established an  
Animal Control Board of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, which  
Board shall:

- a. Operate, manage and maintain the animal shelter.
- b. Enforce all City ordinances concerning animals, which  
terms as used in this Ordinance shall mean all beasts  
and fowl of every kind and nature.
- c. Impound all animals within the City subject to impound-  
ment.
- d. Place, sell or humanely dispose of all such animals as  
come under its control. No animals shall be sold to  
any dealer, unless such dealer meets the standards of  
and holds a license issued by the United States Depart-  
ment of Agriculture to act as a dealer in animals.
- e. Employ personnel to carry out the purposes herein set  
forth.
- f. Make recommendations to the Common Council of the City  
of ordinances concerning animals.

SECTION 2. The Animal Control Board shall be composed of  
seven (7) members, one (1) of whom shall be a member of the Common  
Council of the City and shall be selected by the members of the  
Common Council. The remaining six (6) shall reside within the  
City and shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City.

SECTION 3. The member of the Council serving as a member of  
the Board shall hold his membership upon the Board for a one-year  
term ending upon December 31 of each year.

The members of the Board appointed by the Mayor shall hold  
their memberships for terms of two (2) years, beginning upon the  
first Tuesday of March of each year. Appointments shall be made  
by the Mayor on or before the Twenty-fifth of February of each

year prior to the expiration of the term for which the appointment is made.

Of the six (6) members appointed by the Mayor to constitute the first of such Boards, the terms of office shall be as follows:

A. Three members shall be appointed to hold office to the first Tuesday of March, 1970.

B. Three members shall be appointed to hold office to the first Tuesday of March, 1971.

In the event of a vacancy upon the Board for any reason whatsoever, the Mayor shall fill such vacancy under the same terms and conditions as are provided for the making of regular appointments to such Board, and such appointee shall hold office for the duration of the term of the member whose vacancy is so filled.

SECTION 4. The Board shall hold a meeting upon the second Tuesday in March of each year and at such meeting shall elect a Chairman of the Board who shall hold said office until the next annual meeting in March of the subsequent year. Meetings of the Animal Control Board shall be held at least four (4) times a year as called by the Chairman and any special meetings shall be called by the Mayor, the Chairman or by any four (4) members of the Board requesting such meeting in writing to the Chairman of the Board. Upon the receipt of such request, the Chairman shall thereafter call such special meeting to be held within ten (10) days.

SECTION 5. The Animal Control Board shall prepare and submit to the Common Council of the City for approval an annual budget of funds to be expended in carrying out the purposes hereinabove set forth in Section 1.

SECTION 6. The members of the Board shall receive no salary.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


