ORDINANCE NO. 69-23

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND  
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION  
FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is  
adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have  
submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory  
of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and  
the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the West one half of Section 28, Township 9 North  
Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana described as follows,  
to-wit:

Beginning on the now existing corporation line at the point  
of intersection of the South line of Seventeenth Street with  
the East line of Madison Street; thence Northerly to the point  
of intersection of the North line of Seventeenth Street with  
the East line of Kinser Pike; thence North on and along the  
said East line of Kinser Pike a distance of 1570 feet more or  
less and to the point where a spring branch crosses the said  
East line of the Kinser Pike; thence Northeasterly with said  
spring branch a distance of 1287.0 feet, more or less, to a  
point in the Old Dixie Highway (Old S. R. #37); thence North  
with meandering of the Old Dixie Highway a distance of 907.5  
feet, more or less, to a point due East of a point on said West  
line of Section 28 which is 1856.25 feet South of the Northwest  
corner thereof; thence West 63.0 feet; thence North 220.0 feet;  
thence West 390.0 feet; thence North 300.0 feet; thence West  
500.0 feet more or less to a point on the West line of Kinser  
Pike; thence South on and along the said West line of Kinser  
Pike and said line extended to the South line of Seventeenth  
Street the same being the existing corporation line; thence  
East to the point of beginning.

The privately owned land here in described contains 34.53  
acres more or less and is located between Old State Road No.  
37 and the Kinser Pike at the North edge of Bloomington.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the  
City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be  
extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described  
as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from  
and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication  
in accordance with the law.
