ORDINANCE NO. 69-40

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND  
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION  
FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is  
adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have  
submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory  
of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:


SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and  
the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the West half of Section 16, Township 8 North,  
Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, to-wit: Beginning  
at a point on the now existing Corporation line, said  
point being in the East Right-of-Way line of State  
Highway No. 37 a distance of Two-thousand three-hundred  
fourteen and seventy-five hundredths (2,314.75) feet  
South of the North line of Section 16, Township 8 North,  
Range 1 West in Monroe County, Indiana; thence South on  
and along said East Right-of-Way line to a point that is  
Nine-hundred ninety-two (992) feet North of the South  
line of said Section 16, Township and range aforesaid;  
thence East Six-hundred ten (610) feet; thence South  
Three-hundred ninety-eight (398) feet; thence West Seven-  
hundred ten (710) feet and to the West Right-of-Way line  
of State Highway No. 37; thence North on and along said  
West Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 37 to a point  
on the now existing Corporation line that is Two-thousand  
Three-hundred Fourteen and Seventy-five hundredths  
(2,314.75) feet South of the North line of said Section 16;  
thence East to the point of beginning and containing six  
acres more or less.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the  
City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be  
extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described  
as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and  
publication in accordance with the law.
