ORDINANCE NO. 68-3, 1968

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Part of the South half of Section 29, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, commencing at a corner 43 poles 22 links East of the South half mile post of said section; running thence North 62 poles 18 3/4 links to a corner, thence East 18 poles 15 links to a corner, thence South 62 poles 18 3/4 links, thence West 18 poles 15 links to the beginning, said land comprising 7.3 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
