ORDINANCE NO.68-39

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 30 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957, BY AMENDING SECTION 18 THEREOF ENTITLED "SPECIAL EXCEPTIONS GENERALLY"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 18 of Chapter 30 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957 entitled, "Special Exceptions" by adding thereto the following:

> "All off street requirements as hereinafter set forth are waived and not required within the area bounded by Second Street, Rogers Street, Tenth Street, Indiana Avenue and Henderson Street for commercial structures of three or more stories, apartment house structures of five or more stories.

A Structure shall be considered commercial if 60 per cent or more of the floor space is devoted to retail, and/or commercial sales, and/or professional offices."

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
