ORDINANCE NO. 68- 44

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 5, 1945, THE SAME BEING SECTION 25.5 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 5, 1945, the same being Section 25-5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

"Upon the filing of the application required by the preceding section with the common council, the common council shall then pass upon the application, taking into consideration the applicant, his financial standing, and his equipment for rendering taxicab service in the city; and if the common council finds that it is for the best interests of the city and the citizens thereof that the applicant be issued a license to operate a taxicab line, then the common council shall instruct the city controller to issue the license upon the compliance of the applicant with all other provisions of this chapter. The city controller shall issue to the applicant upon the approval of the common council as above, a license upon the payment of a fee of one hundred dollars for the first taxicab and ten dollars additional for each other taxicab so operated, for any calendar year or fraction thereof of the application. Cash or a certified check shall be deposited by the applicant with the city controller."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
