ORDINANCE NO. 68-<u>49</u>

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 27, 1963, THE SAME BEING SECTION 17-159 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 27, 1963, the same being Section 17-159 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

"Police offiers shall attach to vehicles violating the provisions of this article, a notice to the owner or operator thereof that such vehicle has been parked in violation of the provisions of this article, instructing such owner or operator to report to the chief of police of the city in regard to such violation.

In the event there are no other outstanding and unsatisfied violations, such owner or operator shall pay to the traffic division of the city, in full satisfaction of such violation the sur of two dollars.

In the event there are other outstanding and unsatisfied violations, such owner or operator shall pay to the traffic division of the city the sum of five dollars for the first such outstanding and unsatisifed violation and the sum of ten dollars for each additional outstanding and unsatisfied violation."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
